# 1) Call to Order by the President:

The regular meeting of the FISO Congress and World Obstacle General Assembly was called to order at 18h3o Central European Summer Time by the President Mr. Ian Adamson.

# 6) Membership progress, Mr. Michel Cutait, Acting Secretary General

Mr. Cutait gave a summary of the national federation membership progress with the 102 countries established and in progress: Africa 11, Americas 21, Asia Pacific 30, Europe 41. Other countries in development.

# 7) Recognition Progress and Collaboration with UIPM, Mr. Ian Adamson

President Ian Adamson explained that GAISF has been dissolved, and that FISO remains a member of AIMS, the Alliance of Independent Recognized Members of Sports which is recognized by the IOC.

He further noted the integration agreement signed in August with UIPM and the establishment of an Ad Hoc workgroup, including American Confederation President Mr. Panna Utpaul and Asia-Pacific Confederation President Mr. Al Agra, to manage the integration over the coming years.

# 8) UIPM Obstacle Discipline, Mr. Ian Adamson

President Adamson explained the IOC Session will approve the obstacle discipline on the Olympic program in October.
